



COURSE OFFERINGS

Concert Band

The Concert Band is open to all incoming 9th-grade students as well as 10th–12th-grade students. This ensemble is ideal for students who are new to the program or those looking to build and refine fundamental ensemble skills.

Symphonic Band

The Symphonic Band is the primary performing ensemble for students advancing from Concert Band or those continuing from the previous year's Symphonic Band. Open to students in 10–12 with at least one year of band experience.

Wind Ensemble

The Wind Ensemble is the most advanced concert band in the program and is open to students in grades 10–12 by audition held in March. Representing the program at the highest level, this group performs at adjudicated festivals, special events, and competitions. Students are encouraged to practice independently, take private lessons, and serve as leaders within the band program.

Percussion

The Percussion class is a dedicated ensemble for all percussionists in the program, regardless of grade level. Percussion students perform with the Concert Band, Symphonic Band, and Wind Ensemble.

Jazz Lab

The Jazz Lab is an inclusive and introductory-level jazz band open to all students in grades 9–12. This ensemble is ideal for those new to jazz or looking for a more recreational experience.

Jazz Ensemble

The Jazz Ensemble is the advanced jazz band, open to students in grades 9–12 by audition in April. As the premier jazz group, they compete at regional festivals, perform at school concerts, and participate in professional events.
