## JANUARY UPDATE

Welcome back, and Happy New Year! We're excited to be back together, and the band room is already alive with music as we dive into pep band, small ensembles, festival season, and preparations for the Baltics.

This message also marks a new way we'll be communicating with families. These updates will serve as a running reference so you can easily look back for important information. In addition, a parent volunteer is currently helping update our website so there will be one central place where all band information can be found. Thank you for your patience as that comes together.

## Big News: **Band Growth & New Uniforms**

The Lincoln Band program is reaching an exciting moment of growth. With more students participating than ever before, we are working to ensure that every student has the opportunity to represent our school with pride.

Thanks to a generous donation we were able to purchase a much needed tuba and earmark the remaining **\$30,000 donation** to launch a project to replace our 20+ year old marching band uniform jackets and address a current shortage of uniforms.. Marching uniforms are not funded by the school district, which makes community support essential.

This project allows us to redesign our look to reflect the contemporary vision of Lincoln High School and the pride our students bring to performances across Portland. Because uniform design and manufacturing take approximately 180 days, we must move quickly in order to have uniforms ready for this coming fall.
